

As indicated in Request for proposal for “Technical assistance in conducting a study on children’s access to justice” LRPS-2018-9140871, UNICEF Office for Croatia will provide answers to bidder’s questions received by July 9, 2018.

Below are the questions that UNICEF Office received by July 9, 2018 as well as UNICEF’s answers.

1. Can the applicant be a faculty, specifically the Faculty of Law in Osijek? Team members would be employees at the Faculty of Law, as well as external associates of the Faculty of Law.

Yes. Academic institutions are eligible for applying for this consultancy services and their employees and external associates can be subcontracted for this service.

2. What does it mean that team members must have degrees in the field of social sciences, and can team members be lawyers?

Yes, team member can be lawyers/have a degree in social science. However, it is expected to have a multidisciplinary team of experts.

3. Are there any guidelines/examples of financial offer/budget for this type of application?

The financial offer should contain all costs associated with providing this services.
Financial proposal should be made in accordance with the inputs given in Request for Proposal.

4. Please let us know whether is possible to release timetables for deliverables, for example to postpone end each phase for one month, or recombine time line to match deadline.

Extension will only be possible if the selection process of service provider takes longer than anticipated, but the recombination of the timeline to match deadline is possible. Since, quality assurance of certain deliverables will be carried by UNICEF and external review partner, the final timeline will be determined with the selected service provider and defined by contract.
